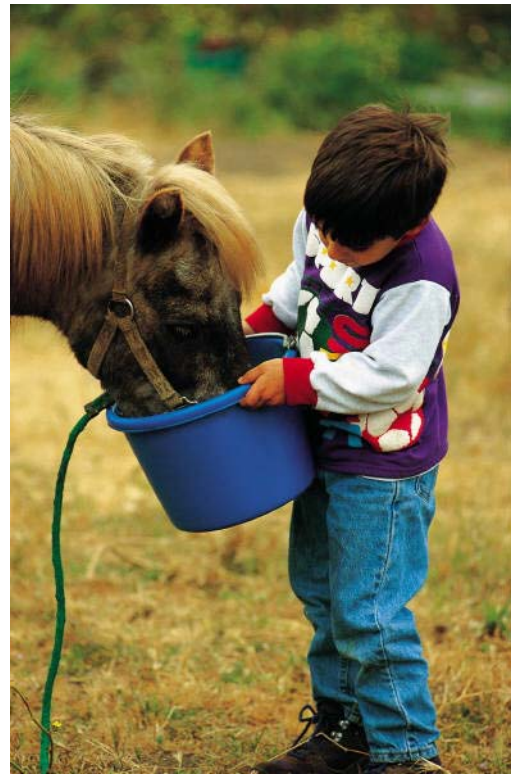


## Rally reminders

To ensure you get the most out of your pony club rally, follow the guidelines listed below

1. Arrive early so you have plenty of time to prepare for the day. Should you require a yard, ensure that you book this with Kim Jameson by the Thursday prior to each rally.
2. Sign the rally book (out the front of the canteen) at each rally, recording your name and the name of your horse/pony.
3. Place your lunch order with the canteen if necessary
4. Check the notice board to see if your first session is mounted or unmounted and who your instructor is. If you are unsure of your colour group, please check with Kim Jameson our rally coordinator
5. Groom and tack up your pony (unless you have an unmounted session first) and line up with the other riders of your group in front of your appropriately coloured drum ready for gear check. (Remember to remove all visible jewellery)



### GEAR CHECK IS FROM 9.30AM!!!

6. Depending which group you are in, your instructor will either collect you from your drum or indicate for your group to meet her/him at the designated area (ie jumping arena) **5 MINS PRIOR TO THE TIME THE LESSON IS DUE TO START.**
7. Please move towards your designated area in an orderly manner and ensure you are ready to start on time.
8. Each lesson will run for approx 50 mins, giving riders the opportunity to have a drink or toilet break as well as offering their horses a drink between sessions. This is also the opportunity to change saddles or add jump boots etc if necessary) **If you change saddles or tack, remember to re-present to gear checker before your next session.**
9. Remember that the instructors are volunteers, giving up their time to teach you the skills to manage your pony and ensure that you have fun!!!!

## General Rules

- All riders must be financial members of Pony Club (see Maryellen for details)
- All riders should have a performance card issued by PCASA (see Tina for details)
- Approved helmets must be worn at all times whilst mounted
- All whips used must have the loop removed
- Only riders with their C certificate are permitted to use dressage whips.
- Riding of horses/ponies around the grounds in their rugs is not permitted
- Cantering/jumping must not take place without an instructor present.
- Bad sportsmanship/ill treatment of ponies/horses will not be tolerated
- All lunging of horses is to be done in the enclosed corral
- All ponies/horses that kick should wear a red ribbon in their tail
