

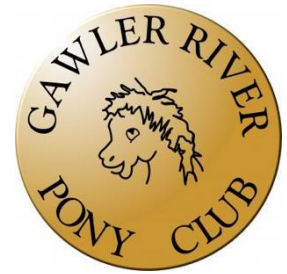

Rules and Regulations

1. This event will be run under PCASA Inc rules www.ponyclub.asn.au it is up to riders to be aware of the rules.
2. Copies of dressage tests are also available on PCASA website <http://www.ponyclub.asn.au/documents/dressage-tests> and EVA tests can be found on <https://www.equestrian.org.au/Eventing-Dressage-tests>
3. NO CARD NO RIDE. All Pony Club performance cards must be current and up to date. Cards must be presented when collecting body numbers. All combinations must be graded and have 4 qualifications within the preceding 12 Months. Horse & rider combinations can enter the height they are graded at and one grade above.
4. EA riders must be current financial members of EA. Complete the PCASA waiver for EA riders at Pony Club events and include with event entry. Pay the PCASA EA Levy with other event entry fees. Cards must be presented when collecting body numbers.
5. Pony Club & Adult Modified Classes. In dressage canter is optional, riders may trot. Show jumping and cross country maximum jump height is 35cm, a short cross country course will be used. Riders may be assisted however they are NOT to be led. As these classes are not competitive no points will be allocated to cards.
6. The Committee reserves the right to combine classes of the same grade if entries are low or to billet out entries if numbers warrant.
7. Riders must supply their own body number holders and medical arm band.
8. Pony Club Riders must wear full pony club uniform for dressage, show jumping & presentations. Club polos may be worn for cross country. Dress for PCASA & EA riders is as per Pony Club rules. Medical arm bands must be worn.
9. In the event of a rider fall, riders will be eliminated. All rider falls must be assessed by the event medical personnel.
10. Riders eliminated excluding a fall during any phase may be able to continue at the discretion of the TD and the grounds committee.
11. Refunds of event entry fees will only be given for withdrawals before the close of entries, unless either a veterinary or medical certificate is produced.
12. Behaviour deemed inappropriate to fellow competitors, officials, visitors or horses may result in elimination.
13. If a mount is deemed dangerous during the event it may result in elimination
14. There are compulsory gear checks before each phase.
15. All protest must be lodged in writing accompanied by \$50 within 30 minutes of results being posted of the relating phase of the protest.
16. Cars without floats attached must be parked outside of the grounds except event organisers or with permission from organising committee.
17. Neither the organising committee of any event to which these rules apply nor the Pony Club of South Australia Inc. accepts any liability for any incident, damage, injury to horses, owners, riders, grounds spectators or any other person.

Camping Information

Camping is available at \$10 per night per person or \$30 per night per family.

There is a designated camping area on the grounds, please report to secretary's office prior to setting up no horse is to be left unattended no exceptions.

All campers are expected to be considerate of others and leave their camping area clean

Presentation Etiquette

All place getters to present in official pony club uniform including helmet. Riders not presented in full uniform will not be presented with prizes.

Points will be allocated to relevant place getters as per PCASA rules.

Place getters cards will not be returned until after the presentations.

The organising committee will endeavour to hold presentations as soon as possible after the last rider has competed.

Yards Information

11 yards available at a cost of \$20 + \$20 Bond (refunded upon inspection). Please ensure you leave these yards clean and respectable.

Campers will be given priority.

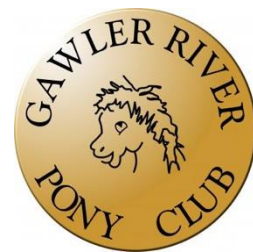
